

Citygarden Media Guidelines

Citygarden was opened to the public in 2009 and was made possible by the generous gift of the Gateway Foundation. While Citygarden is a City park, the cost of design, construction and maintenance are paid by private dollars. It is the intent and priority of the City and the donor to ensure the park is always open and accessible to the thousands of youngsters and adults who visit the park each year. Due to this vision, the City does not permit the park for special events or functions, thus ensuring that no one is prevented from enjoying any part of this beautiful oasis. In order to achieve this goal, the City of St. Louis and the Gateway Foundation ask the media to abide by the following Guidelines:

Do not block interior walks or displays with camera, cables, lighting, or other associated equipment. Limit the use of tripods to perimeter walks and use shoulder-mounted equipment in the interior.

Parking is not allowed on the perimeter walks or in the closed 9th Street right-of-way at any time, for any reason.

While we welcome the use of Citygarden for backdrops to various stories, please refrain from using the area as an outdoor studio.

The use of Citygarden for any commercial or promotional shoots by any organization, including non-profits, is prohibited

By following these simple guidelines, we hope that everyone can enjoy their visit to Citygarden.
